(of singing or a spoken remark) in a quiet voice.  
"It won't be cheap,' he added sotto voce"

**weigh**<sup>1</sup>  
/weɪ/   
verb

1. find out how heavy (someone or something) is, typically using scales.  
"weigh yourself on the day you begin the diet"  
*synonyms:* measure the weight of, measure how heavy someone/something is, put someone/something on the scales  
"the vendor at our market weighs the vegetables carefully"
2. assess the nature or importance of, especially with a view to a decision or action.  
"the consequences of the move would need to be very carefully weighed"
